What is a Read-a-Thon?

A Read-a-Thon is a community event designed to encourage our children to read more and acquire the love of reading. All money raised will help the Oswalt PTSA fund school events and acquire resources to improve the learning environment.

How does it work?

Every time your student reads, or is read to, record the number of minutes on the included Reading Log. Throughout the duration of the Read-a-Thon the students are encouraged to collect pledges from friends, relatives, or neighbors. This can be either as a one time donation or based on the number of minutes read. **All sponsor forms, reading logs, and money must be turned in on Monday, March 11.**

ALL students who **COLLECT A MINIMUM OF \$50** will be invited to an In-N-Out lunch and will participate in the "Pie in the Face" assembly.

The **TOP 3 READERS** in every grade, who read the most minutes, will receive 1) an **invite to an exclusive shopping time** and a **\$25 gift card** to Oswalt Academy's book fair (in March), and 2) participate in the "Pie in the Face" assembly!

GRAND PRIZE: The **TOP PLEDGE COLLECTOR** in each of the following groups: TK - 2nd grade, 3rd - 5th grade, 6th - 8th grade will receive a family pack of 4 tickets to Knott's Berry Farm.

ALL VIP students will be invited to the In-N-Out lunch. **ALL VIP** students who meet the minimum reading time (20 min/night) will participate in the "Pie in the Face" assembly.

What is our goal?

Our school goal is for every child to raise a minimum of \$50. All profits made will support Oswalt Academy's programs and events for TK-8th grade students.
