













Thermal scanners no longer required.



AVID (Dr. Buckmier): - Students will learn strategies and skills that will help them become more successful in their academic classes and to prepare them for college and their future career.

English Language Development (Mrs. Curtis):

For students with English Language

Levels 1-3 only. This class is to help



students develop a solid English language foundation.



Leadership (Mrs. Curtis): Students will design and complete the production of the school's yearbook. Leadership will be responsible for implementing ASB activities and helping PTSA with activities whenever possible.

Computers (Dr. Sigler): Students will learn code

stories, animations, and games with the visual programming language, Scratch and learn to combine learned skills to code more complex programs and games. They will learn key programming concepts such



as representing information digitally, algorithms, variables, and functions. As time permits students may work on additional projects such as stop-motion animation, video projects using WeVideo, Google Sites, the basic structure of a Web page in HTML, spreadsheets, using loops to create music, podcasting, digital presentation tools, and/or tools for creating digital art.

Choir (Mrs. Blackburn): This class is designed for those students who enjoy singing, would like to learn how to sing, or just enjoy working with others. No experience necessary.





Band and Orchestra (Mr. Hobbs):

Students will study music appreciation through various musical genres and participate in performances.



situations. Introduction to robotics will be discussed.






