## Attendance

#### • *Perfect attendance* means:

- 3 warnings (counselor phone call home on third warning)
- After warnings, detention will be assigned.

## Dress Code

- Shorts/skirts length must reach the tips of the fingers when hands to their sides

- Students are provided vegetables and fruits with their meals.


